New Fee Schedule

Effective January 1, 2011

The King County Council has recently enacted several ordinances which have affected fees in the Superior Court Clerk's Office. Specifically:

- KC Ordinance 16966 increases the fee that may be assessed by the Department of Judicial Administration to litigants for failure to bring cases to completion based on noncompliance with the case schedule. This fee is increased to \$50.00.
- KC Ordinance 16967 increases the fee to participants of the continuing legal education program provided by the Department of Judicial Administration to \$200.00.
- KC Ordinance 16968 creates a new fee of \$5.00 per report for the New Case List, and Judgments Audit Reports.
