Request for committee membership must be approved by the committee chairs.

**Lawyer Referral Service members must be admitted to the highest court of one of the 50 states or District of Columbia for at least 1 year prior to joining the committee. Membership in the Lawyer Referral Service is also required.

***Pro Bono Services Committee members must be active volunteers.
