## KCBA Pro Bono Services Neighborhood Legal Clinics

**Volunteer Position:** Clinic Limited Legal License Technician

**Program Description:** The Neighborhood Legal Clinics (NLC) offer free 30-minute client consultations providing limited legal advice and referrals to low-income to moderate income King County residents and Washington State residents with legal issues in King County. NLC strives to make clinics accessible regardless of barriers such as income, education, language or disability. With 36 clinics countywide, NLC volunteers provide counsel in over 8,000 legal matters annually.

**General Duties:**

- Provide advice and resources responsive to the client's legal issue.

**Time Commitment:** NLC volunteers are asked to commit to one clinic shift (typically two hours) every six to eight weeks for at least one year.

**Volunteer Placement:** LLLT placement is based on current program needs.

**Qualifications:**

- Must be licensed as a limited license legal technician in Washington State

**Benefits:**

- Provide an opportunity for low-income to moderate income clients to access legal help
- Attend free or low-cost CLEs, receive CLE credits for pro bono service
- Network within the King County legal community
- Professional Liability Insurance provided by the KCBA

**Training and Support:** All volunteers will be asked to attend the KCBA Pro Bono Services New Volunteer Training in person, and watch program specific training videos online. After this initial training, volunteers will be scheduled to shadow an experienced volunteer at the clinic.
