## Pro Bono Services

### FAMILY LAW MENTOR PROGRAM

The Family Law Mentor Program offers new attorneys or attorneys new to family law the opportunity to represent a client in a family law case. Attorneys are supported by a mentor attorney and the managing attorney of the program as they take on direct representation of a client in a contested dissolution or paternity case. Many new attorneys represent their first client through the Family Law Mentor program and continue to use the skills they acquired through the program long after their cases are completed. Some mentee attorneys continue to supplement their practices with the occasional pro bono service to a low income client in order to help make legal services available to the most vulnerable members of our community, who would otherwise be without representation.

Mentees agree to take one case for direct representation with the assistance of a Mentor. Cases vary in difficulty and length (6 to 12+ months). Mentees are expected to stay on a case through its completion.

#### DV Family Law Clinic

The Neighborhood Legal Clinics (NLC) offer client consultations providing limited legal advice and referrals to low-income to moderate income King County residents and Washington State residents with legal issues in King County. NLC strives to make clinics accessible regardless of barriers such as income, education, language or disability. With 36 clinics countywide, NLC volunteers provide counsel in over 8,000 legal matters annually.

The NLCs offers attorneys with interest and understanding of domestic violence and trauma informed advocacy the opportunity to use your legal skills and expertise to solve problems that truly affect the lives of people who have nowhere else to turn.
